DRAGONFLY MIST

Panel Quilt

Fabric Requirements

One panel (2/3 yard) Panel-CD3891 Multi 2/3 yard Nature-CD3893 Voilet (includes binding) 1/2 yard Nature-CD3894 Multi 1³/4 yards backing fabric of your choice 44" x 64" batting

Cutting

From Panel-CD3891 Multi:

• Trim the panel to 22½" x 42½". (See note)

From Nature-CD3893 Violet:

- Cut four 1½" x width-of-fabric (WOF) border strips. Sub-cut two 1½" x 42½" side borders and two 1½" x 24½" top/bottom borders. (See note)
- · Cut five 2½" x WOF binding strips.

From Nature-CD3894 Multi:

Cut four 3½" x width-of-fabric (WOF) border strips.
 Sub-cut two 3½" x 30½" top/bottom borders.
 Join the remaining strips along the short edges and cut two 3½" x 44½" side borders. (See note)

Quilt Top Assembly

- 1. Sew one 1½" x 42½" CD3893 Violet strip to each side of the panel. Press seam allowances toward the border.
- 2. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " CD3893 Violet strip to the top and another to the bottom. Press seam allowances toward the border.
- 3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to join the CD3894 Multi strips to the quilt center.

Finishing

4. Layer the wall hanging top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. Use your favorite method to bind the quilted wallhanging.

Note: Panels can vary slightly in size. Trim the panel as needed, keeping all desired motifs intact, and leaving at least ¼" beyond motifs to accommodate seam allowances.

If you find your trimmed panel measurements differ from those listed in the cutting instructions, be sure to adjust border lengths accordingly.
