Fabric B	FAME5758-N..... 3/8 yard
Fabric C	FAME5760-N..... Fat 1/8
Fabric D	MILK5777-E..... 5/8 yard
Fabric E	MILK5777-N..... Fat 1/8
Fabric F	MILK5777-R..... Fat 1/8
Fabric G	FAME5763-N..... 3/8 yard
Backing 2 yards
Batting 72" x 28"

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

Fabric A:

- Fussy cut two 18 1/2" x 18 1/2" squares, each centered on a block. (**Patch Blocks**)

Fabric B:

- Cut one 5 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares. (**Blocks**)
- Cut one 3 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 3 1/2" x 20 1/2" strips. (**Outer Border**)

Fabric C:

- Cut one 4 1/2" x 21" strip; sub-cut two 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares and one 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" square. (**Blocks**)

Fabric D:

- Cut one 5 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares, two 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares and four 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares. (**Blocks**)
- Cut one 6" x WOF strip; sub-cut four 6" x 6" squares. (**Blocks**)
- Cut two 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut four 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" rectangles. (**Sashing**)
- Cut three 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 1 1/2" x 58 1/2" strips. (**Sashing**)

Fabric E:

- Cut one 6" x 21" strip; sub-cut two 6" x 6" squares. (**Blocks**)

Fabric F:

- Cut one 6" x 21" strip; sub-cut two 6" x 6" squares. (**Blocks**)

Fabric G:

- Cut five 2 1/4" x WOF strips. (**Binding**)

Piecing Instructions:

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.

- Place one 4 1/2" **Fabric D** square on top of one 4 1/2" **Fabric C** square right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. (Diagram 1) Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2) to make two half-square triangles (HST). Open and press. (Diagram 3)

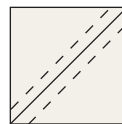

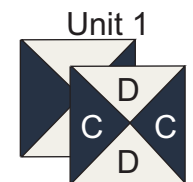
- Place one half-square triangle from Step 1 on top of the other half-square triangle right sides together. Make sure the center seam is going in the same direction on both half-square triangles and the **Fabric C** triangle in the top HST is opposite from the **Fabric C** in the bottom HST. (Diagram 4)
- Draw a diagonal line across the top half-square triangle so that it goes through the sewn seam. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn line. (Diagram 5) Cut on the drawn line to make two quarter-square triangles. Open and press to make two Unit 1 squares. (Diagram 6) Trim the units to measure 3 1/2" x 3 1/2".
- Repeat Steps 1-3 to make four Unit 1 squares total.

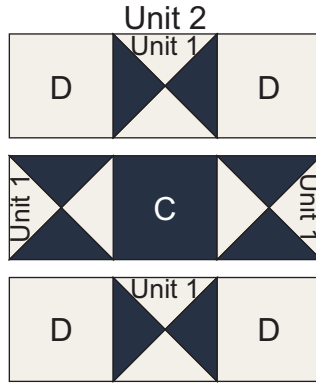

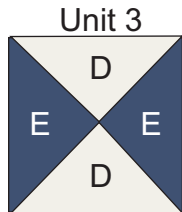

5. Sew one 3 1/2" **Fabric D** square to each end of one Unit 1 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew one Unit 1 square to each side of one 3 1/2" **Fabric C** square to make the middle row. Sew together the three rows lengthwise to make one 9 1/2" Unit 2 square. (Diagram 7)

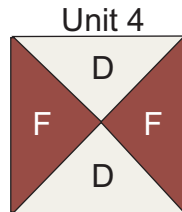

6. Repeat Steps 1-3 and refer to diagrams 8-9 for fabric identification and placement while using 6" squares to make four 5" Unit 3 squares and four 5" Unit 4 squares.

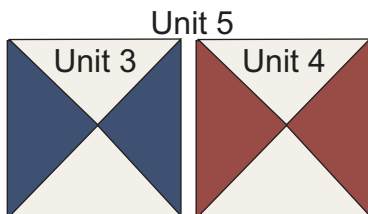

7. Sew one Unit 3 square to the left side of one Unit 4 square to make one 9 1/2" x 5" Unit 5 rectangle. (Diagram 10) Repeat to make four Unit 5 rectangles total.

8. Place one 5 1/2" **Fabric B** square on top of one 5 1/2" **Fabric D** square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. (Diagram 11) Sew 1/4" away from each

side of the drawn diagonal line. (Diagram 11) Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 12) to make two half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 5" to make two Unit 5 squares. (Diagram 13) Repeat to make four Unit 5 squares total.

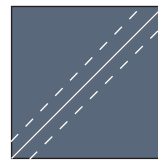

9. Sew one Unit 6 square to each end of one Unit 5 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew one Unit 5 rectangle to each side of one Unit 2 square to make the middle row. Sew together the three rows lengthwise to make one 18 1/2" Block One square. (Diagram 14)

10. Sew together one 18 1/2" **Fabric A** square, one 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" **Fabric D** rectangle, the Block One square, one 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" **Fabric D** rectangle and one 18 1/2" **Fabric A** square, in that order from left to right, to make the 56 1/2" x 18 1/2" Runner Center. (Diagram 15)



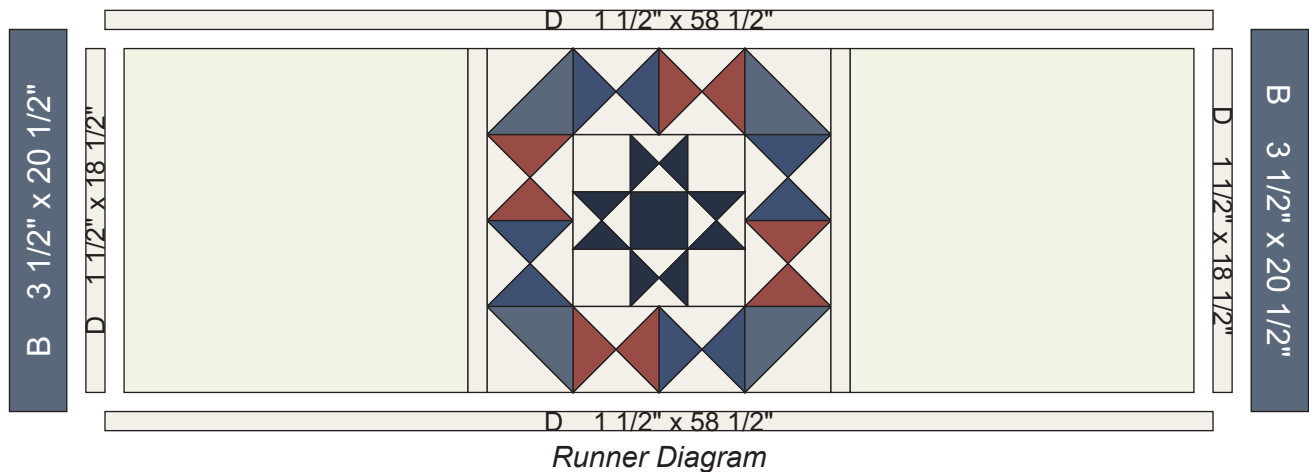
Make (1) = 56 1/2" x 18 1/2" unfinished

Runner Assembly:

11. Sew one 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" **Fabric D** rectangle to each side of the Runner Center. Sew one 1 1/2" x 58 1/2" **Fabric D** strip to the top and bottom of the Runner Center.
12. Sew one 3 1/2" x 20 1/2" **Fabric B** rectangle to each side of the Runner Center to make the runner top.

Finishing:

13. Press backing fabric and trim to 72" x 28".
12. Layer the runner top, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
13. Quilt as desired.
14. Trim layers even with runner top, squaring corners.
15. Attach 2 1/4" **Fabric G** binding strips using your favorite method.

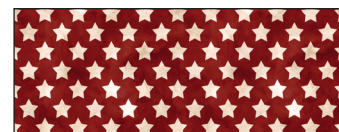

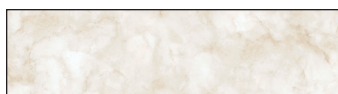
