FLORAL PANEL PILLOWS

FINISHED PILLOW SIZE 16" × 16"

Please read all instructions before beginning this project. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric. Pattern designed by The RBD Designers.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

The materials, cutting, and instructions that follow make (4) total pillows.

This pattern includes basic pillow cover instructions, as well as two options for finishing your pillow cover: binding or turning. Before sewing, choose your finishing method. Then follow the fabric requirements, cutting instructions, and assembly instructions that correspond with your finishing method.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of sewing techniques and terminology. The diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together WST = Wrong Sides Together

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics are from the Love Me More collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) PD15638-PANEL Floral Pillow Panel
1 ½ yards C15630-BLUSH Main (pillow backs)
½ yard C15636-GREEN Seeds (optional binding)

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies (4) Pillow Forms (16" × 16")

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Floral Pillow Panel

Fussy cut (4) 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ × 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ Panel squares centered over the motifs.*

*Note: If the panel motifs do not reach the edge of the required cuts, add coping strips first and then trim to the required sizes once the strips are added.



Blush Main

Cut (4) 10 ¾" × WOF strips. Subcut: (8) 10 ¾" × 16 ½" rectangles for pillow backs



Green Seeds

Cut (8) 2 ¹/₂" × WOF strips for binding (optional)

SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

FLORAL PANEL PILLOWS

PILLOW ASSEMBLY

 Hem one long edge of (1) 10 ¾" × 16 ½" pillow back rectangle by turning the raw edge under ¼" twice and sewing along the inside folded edge. The pillow back piece should measure 10 ¼" × 16 ½". Repeat to make (8) total pieces.

Make (8)

16 ½"

 Layer together (2) pillow back pieces so the hemmed edges overlap to create a 16 ½" × 16 ½" square. Sew a basting seam where the two back pieces overlap, ¼" away from the left and right edges, to make the pillow back. Repeat to make (4) total pillow backs.





- 3. To finish your pillow with binding, skip to "Add Optional Binding". To finish your pillow with the easy turning method, continue to the next steps.
- 4. Place (1) Panel square and (1) pillow back RST and sew around all four sides. Clip the corners. Turn the pillow right side out and press to complete the pillow cover. Place (1) pillow form inside the cover to complete the pillow.
- 5. Repeat step 4 to make (4) total pillows.

ADD OPTIONAL BINDING

- 6. Place (1) Panel square and (1) pillow back WST and sew around all four sides using a $\frac{1}{6}$ " seam.
- Sew (2) Green Seeds binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the pillow using your favorite binding method and press to complete the pillow cover. Place (1) pillow form inside the cover to complete the pillow.
- 8. Repeat steps 6-7 to make (4) total pillows.
