GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

HST = Half Square Triangle

SNF = Stitch and Flip

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include %" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Green Main

Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(5) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as A.

(10) $2" \times 2"$ squares. Label as B.



Coral Botanical

Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(3) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as A.

(6) $2" \times 2"$ squares. Label as B.



Yellow Botanical

Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strip. Subcut:

(5) 2 %" × 2 %" squares. Label as A.

(10) $2" \times 2"$ squares. Label as B.



Green Daisies

Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(4) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as A.

(8) $2" \times 2"$ squares. Label as B.



Yellow Daisies

Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(3) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as A.

(6) $2" \times 2"$ squares. Label as B.



Cloud Plaid

Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(5) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as A.

(10) 2" × 2" squares. Label as B.



Green Plaid

Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strip. Subcut:

(5) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as A.

(9) $2" \times 2"$ squares. Label as B.



Coral Tonal

Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

- (4) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as A.
- (8) $2" \times 2"$ squares. Label as B.



Yellow Tonal

Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

- (6) 2 %" × 2 %" squares. Label as A.
- (12) 2" × 2" squares. Label as B.



Green Botanical

Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(15) 2 %" × 2 %" squares. Label as A.

Cut (2) 2" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(29) $2" \times 2"$ squares. Label as B.



Yellow Flutter

Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

- (11) 2 %" × 2 %" squares. Label as A.
- (2) $2" \times 2"$ squares. Label as B.

Cut (1) 2" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(20) $2" \times 2"$ squares. Label as B.



Blush Daisies

Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strip. Subcut:

(8) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as A.

Cut (1) 2" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(16) 2" × 2" squares. Label as B.



Coral Plaid

Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(7) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as A.

Cut (1) 2" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(14) $2'' \times 2''$ squares. Label as B.



Blush Main

Cut (3) 5" × WOF strips; subcut:

(21) 5" × 5" squares. Label as C.



Blush Flutter

Cut (3) 5" × WOF strips; subcut:

(21) $5" \times 5"$ squares. Label as D.



Cloud Main

Cut (6) 4 ½" × WOF strips. Piece together end-toend; subcut:

- (2) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as E.
- (2) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 55" strips. Label as F.



Cloud Confetti Cotton™

Cut (6) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(85) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as G.

Cut (21) 2" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(168) 2" × 5" rectangles. Label as H.



Coral Seeds

Cut (8) 2 %" × WOF strips. Set (7) aside for binding. From remaining strip, subcut:

- (4) 2 %" × 2 %" squares. Label as A.
- (8) $2" \times 2"$ squares. Label as B.

Cut (5) 1 %" × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 53" strips. Label as I.
- (2) 1 %" × 47 %" strips. Label as J.



Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Please refer to the following general sewing techniques as these methods are referenced throughout the pattern in their abbreviated form.

2-AT-A-TIME HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE METHOD (HST)

Place (2) squares RST. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) square. Sew $\frac{1}{2}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to create (2) HSTs. Press toward the darker fabric. Trim HSTs to the indicated size.









STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance outside the sewn line to %". Flip the smaller piece away from the larger piece and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.

1. Gather the required pieces and use the 2-at-a-time HST method to make the units shown below, referencing the diagram for quantity, proper placement, and orientation. You will have extra HSTs from some prints.

QUILT ASSEMBLY


3. Referring to the following diagrams, arrange HST Units 1-14, SNF Units 15-28, **C**-squares, and **D**-squares in rows. Sew pieces together in each row. Press seams open. Take careful note of the placement of the fabric and the orientation of each unit. Matching fabrics are sewn beside each other to form the secondary pinwheel design.





- 4. Sew the rows together to make the quilt center, which should measure 45 %" × 53".
- 5. Sew (1) I-strip to each side of the quilt center. Next, sew (1) J-strip to the top and bottom. Sew (1) F-strip to each side of the quilt center. Next, sew (1) E-strip to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.





FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

6. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Coral Seeds binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
