



PIECED BLOCKS

 Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 2" square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) B 3-1/2" x 4" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Repeat with another A 2" square at the adjacent corner along the short side of the same B rectangle to complete unit.




2. Sew (2) **B** 3" x 4" rectangles to the opposite long sides of sewn unit to make a row. Make (2). Rows should measure 8-1/2" (horizontal) x 4-1/2" (vertical) raw edge to raw edge.









3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 2" square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) B 3" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Repeat with another A 2" square at the adjacent corner along the long side of the same B rectangle to complete sewn unit.








4. Repeat to make (2) sewn units, and sew units to the opposite sides of (1) **A** 3-1/2" square to make a row.





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5. Sew rows together to make (1) pieced block measuring 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" unfinished. Make (5).






- 6. Make a total number of blocks for the following fabric prints:
 - (3) Blocks: C, E, F and I
 - (4) Blocks: $\boldsymbol{\mathsf{D}}$ and $\boldsymbol{\mathsf{H}}$

PIECED ROWS

Refer to the diagrams below for block placement guide. Arrange and sew together (5) pieced blocks and (4) A 2" x 10-1/2" sashing rectangles to make a pieced row. Make (5) pieced rows.







8. Sew together pieced rows and (4) **A** 2" x 46-1/2" sashing strips to complete quilt center. Refer to Quilt Assembly Diagram on Page 6 for reference.

BORDER ASSEMBLY


- **9.** Inner border: Sew (2) **A** 3" x 56-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by **A** (2) 3" x 51-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- 10. Outer border: Sew (2) G 3-1/2" x 61-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by G (2) 3-1/2" x 57-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

QUILT ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **J** 2-1/4" strips.
