

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Cavalier Crow Panel - Brown (A): • Fussy cut (1) 21 ¹/₂" x 42 ¹/₂" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Jan's Bias Weave Basics - Black (B), cut:
(2) 2 ¹/₂" x 42 ¹/₂" WOF strips, piece as needed.
(2) 2" x 25 ¹/₂" WOF strips.

From the Pumpkins - Pumpkin (C), cut: • (1) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Allover Crows - Pumpkin (D), cut: • (1) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 4 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Daisies - Black (E), cut: • (1) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Star Vines - Tan (F), cut: • (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips.

From the Wildflower Calico - Gold (G), cut: • (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips.

From the Jan's Bias Weave Basics - Green (H), cut:

(3) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 52 ¹/₂" strips.
(2) 1 ¹/₂" x 34 ¹/₂" WOF strips.

From the Border Stripe - Black (I), fussy cut:

- (2) 10 ¹/₄" x 78" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, each centered on the stripe.
- (2) 10 ¹/₄" x 58" LOF strips, each centered on the stripe.

From the Star Vines - Black (J), cut:

• (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Checks - Brown (Backing), cut:

• (2) 62" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 62" x 82" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.


Center Block 1. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " В Fabric B strip to each side of the 21 ¹/₂" x 42 ¹/₂" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 25 ¹/₂" Fabric B strip to the top and A to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 44 1/2". B B Trim block to measure 24 ¹/₂" x 44 ¹/₂" AFTER adding Fabric B borders В Fig. 1 2. Sew (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF Strip Set 1 Unit 1 Fabric F strip to the left side make 3 cut 38 of (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF Fabric G F strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (3) Strip Set 1's total. F G 3. Cut the (3) Strip Set 1's into (38) 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" Unit 1 strips (Fig. 3). Fig. 2 Fig. 3 Unit 2 4. Sew (2) Unit 1 strips together lengthwise make 19 to make (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 2 square (Fig. 4). Unit 1 Repeat to make (19) Unit 2 squares total.

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5. Follow Figure 5 and sew together (6) Unit 2 squares, (2) 4 ¹/₂" Fabric D squares, (2) 4 ¹/₂" Fabric E squares and (1) 4 ¹/₂" Fabric C square to make the Left Side Border.

6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figures 6-8 for component identification and placement to make the Right Side Border, the Top Border and the Bottom Border.





Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 7. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.


8. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Center (1) 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 78" Fabric I strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top edge of the block and stop a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

11. Repeat Step 10 to sew (1) $10 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 58" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 9).

12. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 9), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.




13. Layer and quilt as desired.

14. Sew the (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

15. Bind as desired.
